Dear Mr. Riccio:

In a letter on December 1, 2003, you requested the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to extend the public comment period on the Draft Criteria for Determining Feasibility of Manual Actions to Achieve Post-fire Safe Shutdown published in the *Federal Register* on November 26, 2003. You requested an extension of 60 additional days. Comment period extension requests were also received from 36 other individuals and/or organizations.

In view of the importance of meaningful public stakeholder input on these criteria, the NRC has extended the public comment period by 30 days to end on January 26, 2004 (68 FR 69730). This extension results in a 60 day comment period on the draft criteria. We believe this 60 day period provides a sufficient time to comment.
