Enclosed is the subject report for the October 2, 2002, full participation plume phase pathway exercise of the offsite radiological emergency response plans site-specific to the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant. All objectives of the exercise were demonstrated with no Deficiencies identified. However; there was one Area Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified concerning activation of the siren system and the broadcast of the emergency alert system (EAS) message prior to notifying Hamilton County.
