In accordance with the Licensing Board's Order of December 8, 2003, the Staff is filing this electronic report regarding discussions among the parties relating to the Staff's Motion for Protective Order. The parties have been unable to come an agreement regarding the protective order currently before the Board. Although Counsel for BREDL has stated that BREDL cannot agree to the current terms of the Order, the Applicant and the Staff agree that the Order (with one minor modification that the Staff will address at the December 11, 2003 telephone conference) is adequate to protect safeguards information that may arise in this proceeding. Of the three issues raised by counsel for BREDL at the pre-hearing conference, two have been resolved in the context of the Order. The remaining issue concerns BREDL's request that the staff review BREDL's documents prior to public dissemination to determine whether they contain protected information.
