
In addition, I hate to see any threat to our environment. Ohioans are fortunate enough to border Lake Erie, let's not risk destroying it and its watershed.

In retrospect, closing the company probably isn't the best alternative, selling the company to another company that will strive to make a more positive business.



Please keep the David-Besse nuclear reactor closed.


