SUBJECT: ITEMS OF INTEREST

Attached are various items of interest. The report is a detailed assessment of the Rattlesnake Hills deep well, 13.5 Km from the RRL-2. PNL investigated the well for DOE in 1967-68.

Of interest is the discussion of the coal deposits (pp67-68 and following) from 2100 feet to about 4800 feet. I believe the 2100 foot depth corresponds to Sentinel Bluffs Sequence Basalts which is the sequence the Cohasset is in. (This conclusion is based on RHO's Generalized Structural Cross Section in the SCR (Fig. 3-13) and should be confirmed by Staff.

I noted to Justus I was sending the report. He has an interest.
