

To Whom It May Concern:

Due to a 60 percent rise in radioactive isotope Strontium-90 in our babies' teeth since the late 1980s, with the counties closest to nuclear reactors having the highest levels, I urge you to avoid using a second nuclear reactor at the Clinton, Illinois facility. Instead of a second nuclear reactor at this site which would release radioactive material into the environment, The Environmental Law and Policy Center has developed a plan called "Repowering the Midwest: the Clean Energy Development Plan for the Heartland." Please consider this plan instead of a second nuclear reactor at the Clinton site.
