Dear Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to the referenced NRC Bulletin which requests a one time reporting of the quantity of special nuclear material (SNM) and/or foreign obligated source material in our possession. The only material in our possession that is applicable to this bulletin is depleted uranium. Our installation has ammunition with depleted uranium projectiles stored in various locations. According to our most recent inventories, our plant possesses approximately 216,822 kilograms of depleted uranium at the present time. This depleted uranium is in the form of end use devices such as ammunition components and finished ammunition. After-talking with NRC personnel, it is our understanding that DU in this configuration does not have to be reported to the NMMSS database.
