SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JANUARY 8, 2004, TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL  
WITH SYSTEM ENERGY RESOURCES, INC. REGARDING  
EMERGENCY PLANNING INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THE GRAND  
GULF EARLY SITE PERMIT (ESP) APPLICATION

On Thursday, January 8, 2004, a telephone conference call was held among representatives of System Energy Resources, Inc., and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff. A list of participants is attached. The purpose of the conference, which was held at the request of the NRC staff, was to discuss the applicability of the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Emergency Plan to the Grand Gulf ESP application.

In Section 2.1.4 to Part 1 of the Grand Gulf ESP application, the applicant states that the Emergency Planning Information contained in Part 4 consists of a document identifying the "major features" of an emergency plan which would be developed for the site and that an emergency plan is not intended to be developed until such time as it is necessary to do so, such as upon an application for a combined license (COL). However, Section 1.1 to Part 4 states that this plan, presenting the major features of an emergency plan for the proposed new facility, describes or summarizes applicable portions of the existing Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Emergency Plan currently in place and how they apply, or will apply, to the proposed facility.

During the conference call, the applicant confirmed that while the application describes or summarizes applicable portions of the existing Grand Gulf Emergency Plan, the information contained in Part 4 of the application was to be reviewed as a stand alone document. Only portions of the plan which have been explicitly incorporated by reference should be considered during the staff review of the application.
