By letter dated December 8, 2003, Westinghouse Electric Company submitted for NRC staff review Topical Report (TR) WCAP-10125-P-A, Addendum 1-A, Revision 1, "Extended Burnup Evaluation of Westinghouse Fuel, Revision to Design Criteria." The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of WCAP-10125-P-A, Addendum 1-A, Revision 1. We have found that the material presented is sufficient to begin our comprehensive review. The staff expects to issue requests for additional information by April 15, 2004, and complete its review by May 15, 2004, and estimates that the review will require approximately 125 staff hours including project management time. The review schedule milestones and estimated review costs were discussed and agreed upon in a telephone conference between Rob Sisk of your staff and me on January 8, 2004.
