SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING PROCESS FOR THE CLINTON EARLY SITE PERMIT (ESP) APPLICATION

On Thursday, December 18, 2003, members of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a public environmental scoping meeting in Clinton, Illinois, in support of the staff's review of the Clinton early site permit application. Formal presentations were made by John Tappert and Thomas Kenyon of the NRC staff. Attachment 1 is the transcript (with a copy of the NRC slides) recorded at the meeting. Also included in Attachment 1 are copies of handouts and written statements provided to the NRC staff during the public comment period. Attachment 2 is a list of meeting attendees.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process by providing comments on any issues the public thought the NRC staff should consider while preparing an environmental impact statement for the Clinton ESP application. The staff presentation outlined the overall licensing process under 10 CFR Part 52; provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) review process; discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the Clinton ESP review.

After the formal presentations were given by the NRC staff, an official from Exelon Generation Company, LLC was given an opportunity to address the audience and provide a brief presentation on the ESP application. Members of the public were invited to provide comments. Approximately 100 people attended the session with about 35 people providing comments. Attendees included representatives of the NRC, Exelon Generation Company, LLC, the nuclear industry, State agencies, the press, and members of the public.
