## Cantlemen:

In connection with the transfer of the subject contract to the Oak Ridge Operations Office as of July 1, 195h, the financing, accounting, and auditing functions are being handled for Cak Ridge by Er. L. Denald Backay, Director of Finance. To should like to savise you of the procedures followed by ORO with respect to cost-type contracts such as yours.

Contractors' billings are submitted on Public Voucher accompanied by the usual original supporting documents, such as invoices, payrolls, receiving reports, travel expense statements, and receipts. A desk examination of the vouchers and payment is used without undus delay subject to a post field sudit of other supporting records kept by the contractor and which normally are not required to be furnished with the vouchers, such as original time records and cancelled checks. These field audits are normally made not more frequently than once a year.

Since this procedure has been operating effectively and has been satisfactory to both ORO and its cost-type contractors, we would appreciate your cooperation in effecting a change to this basis effective with your billings for costs incurred after July 1, 195h. For your information and guidance, we are enclosing a general listing of documentation requirements, an information sheet on the preparation of Standard Form No. 103h, and a supply of Form No. 103h, 103ha, 1035 and 1035s.
