Referring to our conversation of Wednesday, May 12th, we will be pleased to convert the material for Canada from conditioned slabs in sizes discussed, weighing approximately 450 lbs. each, to sizes of flat plate specified.

We will produce this material in a similar manner to that produced by Superior Steel Corporation for the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission on Contract AT(30-1)-1412, Amendment No. 1, with the exception of size.

We will be in a position to process this material on a charged weight conversion basis, f.o.b. Carnegie, Pa. for the following prices:
