ORDER

In hand is the January 26, 2004 application of hearing requesters Sierra Club et al. for a stay of the decision of the NRC Staff to issue the second license amendment for the Nuclear Fuel Services' Blended Low-Enriched Uranium (BLEU) project. The application is coupled with a motion to accept it one business day beyond the deadline prescribed in the Rules of Practice.

The motion is granted and the application for a stay will be considered on its merits.<sup>1</sup> Although the NRC Staff previously indicated an intent not to participate in the proceeding, it is hereby directed to respond to the application.
