of January 9, 1984.			
Bob Wright asked if it was appropriate at this time to informally discuss the BWIP's			
current hydrologic testing strategy. He had the feeling that some changes in the BWIP's			
position concerning this subject may have occured since-the NRC workshop last summer,			
when the testing strategy was last discussed. He was told that this was probably an			
appropriate subject to discuss during their visit and that BWIP would consider the request			
and inform him of the decision on December 21, 1983.			
Mr. Wright also asked about deviation drilling performed by the BWIP. He was under the			
impression that such drilling was being done at RRL-2. He was told that such drilling			
had been undertaken at borehole DC-16C and that studies of the core were now under way.			
It was suggested that initial results could be discussed with NRC at the January 9, 1984,			
meeting.
