SUBJECT: Request for Additional Information Regarding Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1 License Amendment Request, "Various Administrative and Editorial Changes"

During the NRC review of Reference 2, Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) was requested to provide corrections and additional information on the proposed relocation of various Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1 (FCS) Technical Specification (TS) Sections.

1. The first sentence of the sixth paragraph of Page 2 of Attachment 1 (Section 2.0) of Reference 2 specifies the following:

"TS Section 3.17(5)(ii) are proposed to be changed to delete the words...."

This is corrected to specify the following:

"TS Section 3.17(5)(iii) *is* proposed to be changed to delete the words...."

2. With respect to TS Section 3.17(5), OPPD commits to reporting serious steam generator tube degradation meeting the criteria of Reference 3, Section 3.2.4(A)(3)(a) or Section 3.2.4(A)(3)(b).
3. The first sentence of the second paragraph of Page 3 of Attachment 1 (Section 2.0) of Reference 2 specifies the following:

The details of TS Section 5.6, "Reportable Event Action" are proposed to be relocated to FCS Plant Procedures.

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This is corrected to specify the following:

The details of TS Section 5.6, "Reportable Event Action" and TS Section 5.9.2, "Reportable Event" are proposed to be relocated to FCS Plant Procedures.

4. Excerpts from the FCS Updated Safety Analysis Report (USAR) and Plant Procedures are also provided to assist in the review of items relocated from the TS by Reference 2.

This letter contains the following commitment:

- OPPD commits to reporting serious steam generator tube degradation meeting the criteria of Reference 3, Section 3.2.4(A)(3)(a) or Section 3.2.4(A)(3)(b).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. (Executed on February 9, 2004)
