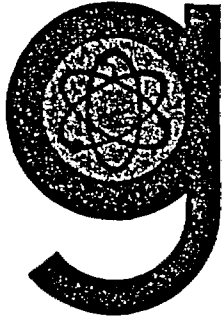


SUBJECT: General Electric Morris Operation Physical Security
