SUBJECT: MEETING WITH THE STATE OF UTAH; FEBRUARY 11 AND 12, 1985

The State of Utah requested a meeting with the NRC to discuss technical issues and the State's concerns related to the Davis and Lavender Canyon sites. A meeting was agreed to and occurred February 11 and 12, 1985.

There were two parts to the meeting, the first administrative and the second technical. The first occurred Monday afternoon and was attended by representatives of Utah, WMRP, and WMPC. Topics included: 1) the current Utah Review Group organization; 2) the NRC organization and structure of the SALT Team; 3) various aspects of the general role of NRC and the HLW repository program and 4) the agenda for the technical meeting.

The technical meeting occurred Tuesday and was attended by representatives from WM, WMRP, WMPC, WMGT, NRR, FCUF; Utah Office of Nuclear Waste; and the National Park Service (invited by Utah). The various areas of concern brought up by Utah are outlined in the enclosed agenda (Enclosure 1). Attendees of the meeting are listed in Enclosure 2.

Utah and the National Park Service (NPS) identified various concerns and technical points. The NRC staff was already aware of points identified by Utah and NPS, however, Utah and NRS had certain data that NRC was not aware of. The NRC staff requested that this data be sent as soon as possible and that an attempt would be made to incorporate any new data into our review of the Draft EA's, as time allowed.

In addition to hearing the State's discussion of existing data and concerns, the meeting allowed Utah and the NRC to get a better understanding of each others organization and role in the high level waste program. The meeting also
