INVITATION TO SPEAK

As part of our consultation and cooperation activities with the salt states of Mississippi, Texas, Utah and Louisiana, our office holds meetings every two months in Columbus, OH to discuss our program with the salt states and NRC. As part of these meetings we invite speakers on topics of special interest to the program to meet with the group. At our last meeting on September 20-21, 1983 the salt state representatives requested that an EPA representative speak on the EPA proposed standard for our next meeting November 15-16, 1983. We concur with this request and invite you, or your representative to address our state contacts at this time. We propose that you plan to speak for a period of one hour followed by a question and answer period with the audience. We would like to videotape your talk, unless you object, and add it to a new series of technical talks we are making available to the states and universities for their educational use. We currently have two other videotapes as a result of similar meetings, one by Dr. Thomas Pigford discussing the NAS report and one by Hassell Hunter of CONOCO discussing big hole drilling experience.

The agenda for the November 15-16, 1983 meeting is still flexible enough that you may choose which day you would prefer, morning or afternoon. Whatever your choice, we would appreciate your staying after your talk for the rest of the day to be available to meet with the salt state representatives and answer any individual questions.


