ORDER

As announced during a February 4, 2004, telephone conference with counsel for the parties, the parties have agreed to a schedule for the submission of the written presentations in this materials license amendment proceeding involving the Sequoyah Fuels Corporation's Gore, Oklahoma site. In some measure, the proposed schedule was dictated by a filing with the NRC Staff that SFC is to make on February 17, 2004—which filing apparently will involve modifications to the reclamation plan for the Gore site that is the subject of the proceeding.

In the circumstances, the proposed schedule appears reasonable and is hereby adopted. It is as follows:

- April 30, 2004 – Oklahoma and Cherokee Nation written presentations
- May 28, 2004 – SFC and NRC Staff responsive written presentations
- June 11, 2004 – Oklahoma and Cherokee Nation rebuttal written presentations

SFC counsel is to advise Judge Baratta and the undersigned of the date of the submission of the additional material to the NRC Staff. In the event that the submission does

not take place on or before February 17, the foregoing schedule will be subject to adjustment. Specifically, one day will be added to each segment of the schedule for each day beyond February 17 that the submission of the material in question to the Staff is delayed.
