

Purpose Of Telecon


NRC Review Plan, QA Programs for Site Characterization.

Text Of Telecon

Bob Cook said he had a copy of something titled "Recommendations for Exception to the NRC Review Plan." He recognized some of the concepts put forth there from discussions among he, Steve Baker, and I. Bob asked me if I knew who had written this. I responded that I had written these comments, in assembling the results of a review of the subject plan by myself and others of Site Department staff. Bob stated that, after some further study, he would like to discuss the comments. He considered them well written and very useful for discussion, although he felt he had some disagreements with the content. I offered to discuss the specific comments with him in detail, with regard to their nature and intent. Bob then inquired after the status of the comments; what was being done with them. I responded that Wally Keltner had chaired several meetings on the NRC Review Plan that had included discussion on these comments, and that as I understood it, he was responsible to compile a Rockwell/BWIP position. Bob asked why wasn't QA doing this instead of Keltner. I did not profess to know, but observed that QA personnel had participated in Keltner's meetings, and further ventured that I felt it was appropriate for the line organization to actively pursue a working relationship with the Review Plan, as the primary people who had to operate under it. Bob concluded promising to contact me again when he was ready to discuss details of the comments.
