The Commission was briefed by the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste (ACNW). The following items were discussed:

- 1) Responses to questions accompanying Working Draft #3 of the EPA HLW standards
- 2) Uncertainties of the EPA HLW standards
- 3) Role of expert judgment in the licensing of a HLW repository
- 4) Impressions from a recent ACNW visit to the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses (CNWRA)

The Chairman requested the ACNW to investigate the feasibility of a systems analysis approach to reviewing the over-all high level waste program, including the short and mid-range technical milestones for handling high level waste and to report back to the Commission the ACNW's recommendations as to the scope and advisability of it undertaking such a review.
