SUMMARY

EXPECTED ATTENDEES:

- (1) MAY 11-15, 1987 TEST HOLE DATA REVIEW, CURTIS TAYLOR OF CERT; W. BREWER & W. LINDLEY AND PERHAPS ELLEN KAYWOOD OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON AND AN EWA CONSULTANT WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN THE DATA REVIEW. H. LEFEBVRE INDICATED THAT JIM WARNER OF THE NRC TECHNICAL BRANCH WOULD BE PRESENT. PURPOSE OF DATA REVIEW IS TO "FOLLOW-UP" ON POSSIBLE "NEW" WELL HOLE DATA INITIALLY IDENTIFIED BY ABDOUL ALKAZIWEEDY OF CERT AND BOB COOK OF NRC. THE DATA REVIEW WILL INITIALLY FOCUS ON CONFIRMATION OF THE VERACITY OF THIS "NEW" INFO AND WILL THEN CONCENTRATE ON WELLS CONSTITUTING A PART OF THE FORTHCOMING PRE-EIS GEOPHYROLOGY PUMP TEST. IT IS NOT KNOWN AT THIS TIME WHAT RECORDS ARE AVAILABLE AND WHICH HOLES ARE INSTALLED IN THE TRAILER LOCATED AT THE ES LOCATION.
- (2) DOCUMENTATION OF SUMMARY OF DATA REVIEW - S. HART INDICATED THAT A SUMMARY CONSOLIDATED REPORT, SIMILAR TO THAT CUSTOMARILY PRODUCED BY THE NRC, WOULD BE PREPARED PRIOR TO DEPARTURE FROM THE HANFORD AREA.
- (3) DOE - STATE - TRIBES - NRC MEETING IS ENVISIONED FOR THE LAST WORK DAY. THE DATE OF THE DATA REVIEW CLOSURE IS FLEXIBLE AND IS DEPENDENT UPON THE NATURE OF THE DATA REVIEWED.
- (4) DOE REQUEST - THE DATA REVIEW, DATED UPON DOE'S REQUEST, IS BEING CONDUCTED AS A JOINT (RATHER THAN INDIVIDUAL ORGANIZATION) EFFORT IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE THE IMPACT ON DOE'S STAFF RESOURCES.
- (5) FUTURE NATURAL RESOURCES/TECTONICS WORKSHOP - S. HART INDICATED A POSSIBLE WORKSHOP WOULD PROBABLY BE REQUESTED BY THE TRIBES/STATE ON THE ABOVE MATTER. THIS MATTER WILL BE DISCUSSED BY THE PARTIES (STATE-TRIBES-NRC)

DURING THE COURSE OF THE TEST HOLE DATA REVIEW.

- (6) FOSSIL REPORT - S. HART INDICATED THAT CERT & THE STATE OF WASHINGTON HAVE RECEIVED DR. ESTELLA LEOPOLD'S REPORT DEALING WITH A PALYNOLOGY (FOSSIL) RESTUDY OF COAL SAMPLES TAKEN FROM THE RATTLESNARE HILLS DEEP TEST HOLE. S. HART NOTED THAT THE LEOPOLD REPORT SUGGESTS AN UNUSUAL AGE FOR THE COAL WHICH IS INCOMPATIBLE WITH THAT OF THE UNDERLYING & OVERLYING BASALTS. (NOTE: THE HLTG HAS NOT YET RECEIVED A COPY OF THIS REPORT WHICH WAS RECEIVED BY DDC IN FEBRUARY).
- (7) JUNE GEOLOGY/GEOPHYSIC DATA REVIEW - CERT INTENDS HAVING A REPRESENTATIVE AT THIS REVIEW.
