SUMMARY

I contacted Nancy Horvis, attorney in the Washington State firm of Horvis, Cockrill, Weaver, and Bjur, to inquire about the status of Washington's HLW litigation with DOE. Horvis, Cockrill, Weaver, and Bjur provide counsel for the Yakima Indian Nation. I first asked her how things were going in Washington, to which she replied that, while the weather was cold, things were really heating up — many recent newspaper articles concerning safety at Hanford. Upon my inquiry about the litigation status, she said she would send me their litigation Status Report, which, I believe, is issued once a month. I also mentioned that she should be receiving NRC's Comments on DOE draft EIS on Hanford Defense Waste Disposal by the end of this week.
