Materials

Risk Informed Regulation

Large Break Loss-of-Coolant Accident (LBLOCA) Redefinition

The WOG will present a revised plan on moving forward on LBLOCA Redefinition.

Probabilistic Risk Assessment (PRA) Scope and Quality

The WOG objective is to continue its role as a leader in PRA applications. The resolution of PRA scope and quality issues in a predictable and programmed manner will benefit the already approved applications when updated and will benefit the larger scale applications associated with Risk Informing Regulations under Option 2 and Option 3.

Critical Skills

The WOG objective is to preserve and transfer the fundamental knowledge of the analysis, design, operation, and licensing of nuclear power plants. This is becoming a critical issue as the workforce ages and retires.

Succession Planning

The WOG objective is to maintain strong management of the WOG through the identification of potential leaders for subcommittee and Steering committee positions.
