Dear Mr. Palladino:

The Department of Energy has been implementing, during the course of the last several years, the requirements of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982 (Pub. L. 97-425). This Act provides for a Federal response to the national problem of the large accumulations of spent nuclear fuel and high-level radioactive waste. The Act establishes a Federal responsibility for the permanent and safe disposal of such waste.

The Nuclear Waste Policy Act provides for a comprehensive cooperative effort involving States, affected Indian Tribes, private industry, and other Federal Executive Branch agencies in solving a set of complex technical and institutional challenges. The Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management, the Office within the Department of Energy charged with the responsibility for implementing the Nuclear Waste Policy Act, has been working in cooperation with members of your Department in a number of areas, including the development of the Draft Project Decision Schedule for the Radioactive Waste Management System, a copy of which is enclosed.

The Project Decision Schedule is required to be developed by Section 114(e) of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act and is to portray the optimum schedule for the attainment of operation by January 1998 of the Radioactive Waste Management System. The schedule describes the activities associated with the development and operation of the system and establishes deadlines for the affected Federal agencies to take action related to those activities. Provisions are also included which require an affected Federal agency to submit a report to the Secretary of Energy and the Congress should the agency determine that it cannot comply with a deadline in the Project Decision Schedule or that it has failed to comply. The report submitted is to contain an explanation as to the agency's inability to take the required action by the time specified in the Project Decision Schedule.

The Project Decision Schedule is derived from another major program document entitled The Mission Plan for the Civilian Radioactive Waste Management Program (DOE/RW-0005, June 1985). The Mission Plan provides a

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comprehensive discussion of the program's strategy and reference schedules for achieving the initiation of operation of the Radioactive Waste Management System and acceptance of spent nuclear fuel and high-level radioactive waste by January 1998. The Project Decision Schedule specifies those activities and deadlines for taking action for which Federal agencies have responsibility.

The Department of Energy issued a Preliminary Draft Project Decision Schedule (50 FR 1616, January 4, 1985), for Federal agency review and comment. Comments received have been considered and other changes, resulting from a re-evaluation of the Civilian Radioactive Waste Management Program, have also been incorporated in the document. Please note that the Department has incorporated a new requirement in the Draft Project Decision Schedule that was not contained in the Preliminary Draft. We are requesting that the affected Federal agencies review the statutes, regulations, and permits that are listed in Section 10 of the Draft Project Decision Schedule and submit a report to the Department by January 1, 1986 as to their specific application to the Radioactive Waste Management Program. In addition, any statutes, regulations or permits not identified are also to be included in the report to be submitted.

I am requesting, at this time, that you provide your comments on the Draft Project Decision Schedule by September 13, 1985. Subject to resolution of outstanding issues, your response will serve as your agency's initial commitment to the activities, attendant schedules, and deadlines for taking action that are appropriate to your agency. If it is necessary, staff of the Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management will meet with your staff to resolve any problem areas identified during your review.

The Department appreciates the cooperation and support that has been extended to us in the development of the Project Decision Schedule. I look forward to the continuation of this positive relationship.


