Subject: Rapiscan Device (Encore Inc.)			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>The licensee requested to add a device (Rapiscan) that uses a J.L. Shepherd irradiator. It appeared from their letter that they want to buy and store the device until the device is approved by the State of California. The device is on a USDA site in Arizona undergoing some prototype testing under reciprocity.</p> <p>I had talked to John Fassal of California Bureau of Radiation Control in December about this device and Rapiscan's intention to distribute it. I called John Fassal to determine if the device is now approved and if Rapiscan's license authorizes distribution of the device.</p> <p>He confirmed that Rapiscan's license does not authorize distribution of the device. He also stated that they have received application for safety evaluation of the device but he could not tell me about the outcome of their review until completion of the review. He stated that they can not authorize its distribution until the review of the device is completed and a certificate is issued.</p>
