In addition, they should identify possible methods by which such information exchanges could occur. The Commission's representative member of the NARUC Executive Committee should be kept fully informed of activities in this area and will keep the Commission informed of progress.

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Once workable options for how such exchanges of information are structured, including areas in which further coordination with NARUC is desirable, the Commission's representative to NARUC will provide to the Commission the staff's and his recommendations.
