The NRC staff discussed with the Commission its views on the status of the high-level radioactive waste program as undertaken by DOE's proposed program approach.

The Commission requested that the staff prepare a letter to DOE for the Chairman's signature, in anticipation of the forthcoming briefing of the Commission in December by Dr. Dreyfus, which indicates a) the Commission's desire to hear more about the substance of the HLW program, and b) how DOE intends to provide under the new approach assurances that NRC will be provided at early stages in the process the information necessary to meet its statutory licensing responsibilities.
