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the basis, an entire re-evaluation of the plans and program from some other viewpoint would need to be initiated. This will take considerable time and would necessarily have to be based on some technical logic, not yet identified. On the other hand, if we are not changing the ground rules for assessing BWIP plans and programs, i.e., those pertinent to resolution of key NRC issues, then the outline must highlight major NRC issues, not BWIP issues. This feature is clearly missing from the attached outline.

Aside from the impracticality of accomplishing the requested changes in the time frame identified (1 week), I find the proposed outline unsatisfactory for discussing separate technical issues. I cannot make a coherent technical story by grouping unrelated issues in one section, unrelated evaluations in another and unrelated actions to be resolve issues in yet a third section.

Also, I find the items 1 and 2 of the attached outline redundant with either the SCR itself or other chapters or appendices of the SCA and, hence, a waste of space, not pertinent to addressing the major technical issues.
