TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission was briefed by the Office of the Inspector General and the NRC staff on the audit of the high-level waste (HLW) Licensing Support System (LSS). The Commission reaffirmed its commitment to a system that satisfies the original purpose of the LSS and encouraged the staff to take a stronger leadership role in attempting to resolve the fundamental issues involving the roles of DOE and NRC and with respect to the LSS and the manner in which it will be funded. The Commission also expressed a need to initiate a prototype effort immediately to begin surfacing LSS issues related to document identification, inclusion, and access. The Commission also should be informed on the approach for: (1) applying the topical guidelines to ensure relevant documents are identified and (2) capturing the decision process so that DOE and NRC decisions related to key licensing issues, including their technical and logical bases, can be retrieved.
