The Washington State Nuclear Waste Board and Advisory Council have scheduled a U.S. Department of Energy (USDOE) presentation on the recently released data regarding "radioactive releases" at Hanford over the past 40 years. The USDOE presentation has been scheduled for 1:30 p.m. on March 20th at the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council Hearings Room, 4224-6th Avenue, Building #1, Lacey, Washington.

Governor Gardner has requested a joint Washington/Oregon/Affected Indian Tribe Review Committee to identify and evaluate past, current, and future environmental impacts from the releases. The first meeting of the joint Washington/Oregon/Affected Indian Tribe Review Committee will be held after the USDOE presentation.

The Nuclear Waste Board welcomes and encourages public participation during the monthly meetings. The Chairman will invite public comment at various points during the meeting. In addition, if there are specific agenda items which you wish to comment upon please sign the sheet on the back table and you will be invited to comment when the Board reaches that agenda item.
