I agree with Steve's findings. Perhaps we should withdraw all external web pages except for those dealing with on-going licensing and similar required "sunshine act" items.

Examples of potential vulnerabilities:

Non-power reactors have several times in the past been recognized as targets, so this is an evident concern.
