Has there been any additional discussions of how we might withhold "terrorist-sensitive information" that is normally in a licensee's application. Two real-time examples include license renewal. In one, we expect to get an environmental report that would normally have site drawings that we might now consider "terrorist-sensitive." In the other, we have asked a licensee to give detailed information about severe accident management that will likely have plant vulnerability material that we would prefer be withheld. If we are unable to get licensees to request withholding under the High-2 criteria, would it be possible to expand the use of "commercial information" under Criterion 4?
