We have a backlog of preliminary and final ASP analyses to be sent to the licensee. We held these up because of the Agency's issue with the release of sensitive information to the public relating to the identification of plant vulnerabilities. Based on the recently issued interim guidance from the EDO on the classification of information to be withheld from public disclosure, we determined that ASP analyses meets two of the three criteria---Information provides a vulnerability to sabotage or attack; Information provides a method for sabotage or attack.

In light of the sensitivity, what methods, if any, has Projects used recently (post 9-11) to transmit sensitive information to the licensee without public disclosure?

Licensee's review of preliminary ASP analysis is very critical in the ASP process.

Can you please help us out in finding a way that would be agreeable with Projects to sent analyses to the licensee?
