Walt,

Can the following questions be answered, and who would answer them?

1. What has already been done to review the new web site?
2. How much effort would be required to perform the task of reviewing the new web site?
3. How long do we realistically have to do the review of the new web site, considering that it isn't activated yet?
4. Is public access to ADAMS (via CITRIX) included in this task, or just what is on the web site? Are we also concerned with publicly available material at the PDRs, assuming they are still open to the public? It would occur to me that the content in ADAMS that is available to the public, and that in the PDRs, would be just as much of concern as the material available in HTML format on the web site.
5. Can you make the case to OCIO that adjustments in priorities need to be made, in view of the national emergency arising from the terrorist attacks? It would seem to me that such a change in priorities, and the fact that NMSS resources for maintaining safety and security are already being seriously taxed, would be ample justification for modifying the terms of the rotational assignment under which I am now operating.
