SUMMARY

The following significant matters were discussed:

(1) Hydrocarbon potential of the Hanford area - The State intends to issue a contract to a petroleum consulting firm, which, if coupled with data & resources available to the State would result in a comprehensive, state-of-the-art assessment of the hydrocarbon potential of commercial production of the BUEP RRL. H. Lefevre expressed his interest in this effort, which according to Dr. Brewer, will hopefully be completed by October 1, 1986. H. Lefevre indicated that we could consider this a joint effort with the NRC possibly providing some petroleum expertise to assist in the effort through our own staff and possibly through petroleum geologists with our contractor (the Bureau of Reclamation). Dr. Brewer indicated this matter is of top priority to the State (see attachments)

(2) NRL indicated recent receipt of DOE documents/data - Dr. Brewer

expressed considerable interest in all the items transmitted to NRL through the two June 9, 1984 DOE to NRL letters (D. Olson to J. Linehan). NRL indicated that A. Lassila of DOE had indicated that, if requested, these same data would be provided to the State.

3) Final EA Review - State is currently reviewing the Hartford

Defense EIS and has not yet embarked upon the FEA Review.

4) Status Meeting with DOE on June 24-25 - Because of other

commitments, Dr. Brewer will not be able to attend the

Richland, WA meeting of June 24-25 with DOE and the

Tribes. He (Dr. Brewer) does intend to send a representative,

however.

5) Increased level of State involvement - Since BULP has been selected for characterization the State will be:

a) Increasing their technical staff.

b) Appointing their own on-site representative and will have ready access to the Affected Tribes' on-site reps.

c) Pushing for Federal funding of site investigations.

d) Pushing DOE for 5-6 technical meetings per year.

These meetings would be hopefully attended by (with participation as well) the NRC, CERT (a tribal consultant), and other consultants, as appropriate.

NOTE: CERT, from Denver, will also be establishing an office in the Richland area.
