MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

*Amend 8  
7-22/16-2*

Talked with Ted Workinger, OID re Curtiss-Wright license, Amendment No. 7. It is their understanding Curtiss-Wright will be getting Hanford WW-1 waste solution from the chemical separations plant. This solution will contain small amount of plutonium. Curtiss-Wright is interested in the elements indicated in Amendment 7 which are separated out by the silica and phosphate precipitation process. The Amendment No. 7 application is misleading in that it infers they will receive this precipitate from Hanford but this is not the case according to OID therefore further licensing is involved due to other mixed fission products and the special nuclear material contained in the bulk solution received by Curtiss-Wright.

The licensing of special nuclear material was discussed with Charles McCallum of Licensing Branch. He indicated Curtiss-Wright should apply for the plutonium and we could license it on Curtiss-Wright's byproduct license since the plutonium should be in small (mg) quantities.

It was agreed that Curtiss-Wright will have to apply for amendment to cover special nuclear and any other material possessed in this bulk waste solution. OID is to notify Curtiss-Wright about this.
