Dear Mr. Beam:

This is in response to your letter of January 22, 1960, concerning plutonium and uranium possessed under License No. 37-2416-2.

This license is considered to be a multiple license covering byproduct, source and special nuclear material. The combination of licenses is authorized under Section 70.21(b), Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 70. Material can be charged against this combination license just as against any other source or special nuclear material license.

Please note that Condition 12 of License No. 37-2416-2 states:

"12. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Title 10, Part 20, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, 'Standards for Protection Against Radiation;' Title 10, Part 30, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, 'Licensing of Byproduct Material;' Title 10, Part 40, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, 'Control of Source Material;' and Title 10, Part 70, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, 'Special Nuclear Material.'"

Therefore, it is necessary under this license to satisfy the requirements of 10 CFR 40 and 10 CFR 70, including record keeping and reporting requirements, just as on any other source or special nuclear material license.

It is our understanding that other AEC offices are taking steps to have AEC Form 388 withdrawn since it was not applicable to the case at hand.
