Dear Mr. Buchanan,

I wish to acknowledge and thank you for your letter of
February 4, 1960.

We do and have been observing the requirements of 10 CFR 40
and 10 CFR 70, including record keeping and reporting requirements and
our records are open for inspection at any time. My reference to ad-
ditional bookkeeping was with respect to charging the small amount of
depleted uranium and plutonium, contained in the subject zirconium-
niobium, to a source and special nuclear material license. Our admin-
istration, puts inventory responsibility for by-product, and source
and special nuclear materials respectively under two custodians, which
would have necessitated keeping duplicate records. We are appreciative
of your work in clarifying the situation.

Will you be kind enough to forward for my information one
copy of 10 CFR 71 - Regulations to Protect Against Accidental Conditions
of Criticality in the Shipment of Special Nuclear Material.
