Reference is made to your letters of October 31, 1960 and November 23, 1960, concerning the modification of byproduct material license 37-2416-2. That license has recently been changed to a license authorizing only storage at the Quehanna, Pennsylvania site. It reflects in no way an active program controlling the radiation safety aspects of your proposed use at Albuquerque, New Mexico.

In order to obtain byproduct material license coverage for your proposed possession and use of Krypton 85, it will be necessary that you submit application on Form AEC-313. This application is to be completed in detail to enable us to make a complete evaluation of radiation safety aspects of your proposed program.
