SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR COMMENTS REGARDING DEPARTMENT OF AIR FORCE'S
DETERMINATION OF NO EFFECT

Dear Ms. Carmody:

By letter dated June 9, 2003, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requested comments from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service regarding any potential impacts to endangered and threatened species and critical habitats as a result of reclamation activities being conducted at Eglin Air Force Base. This information was necessary to allow the NRC to complete an environmental assessment of the proposed activities.

By letter dated July 7, 2003, you responded to our request. In your letter, you suggested that a biological information report be developed to determine whether the activities will directly, indirectly, and/or cumulatively affect such species or habitat.

The Department of the Air Force informed the NRC by letter dated February 11, 2004, that it had concluded that the proposed activities would have no effect on either species or habitat. A copy of that letter is enclosed. We request that you review the Air Force's decision, independently ascertain whether the decision was appropriate, and inform the NRC of whether the decision satisfies the recommendations addressed in your July 7, 2003, letter. Details of the Air Force's determination were discussed in a February 11, 2004, telephone conversation between Stan Simpkins of your staff and Robert Evans of the NRC's staff.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and your response will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). 
