The following information is submitted in connection with this request for subject consultant.

RATIONALE FOR CONTRACT:

A major effort is underway to develop the computer program EBSPAC. This code incorporates several new performance evaluation models and interfaces with external codes and technical databases. The Center currently has a scope of activities that would require the services of a dedicated engineering code developer with significant experience. While there is a long-term need for this talent at the Center, the current budget constraint does not permit the addition of permanent staff at this time. Mr. Pennick has the necessary technical background and experience to support the EBSPAC developmental need in a timely, cost effective, and technically superior manner.

DAYS/HOURS REQUIRED:

It is anticipated that approximately 300 manhours will be needed for three months starting April 1, 1991. The requirement is extendable for additional three-month periods at the above rate.
