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Background – New Part 70

- Unique Regulation Performance requirements for high and intermediate consequence events & criticality, "Items Relied On For Safety", ISA Summary, baseline design criteria.
- Subpart H: risk informed.
- Subpart H applies to:

Scope of Part 70

- Part 70 covers licensing of Special Nuclear Materials (SNM) for licensees authorized to own, deliver, receive, possess, use, or transfer of SNM.
- Uranium processing, fuel fabrication, uranium enrichment*, UF₆ conversion, Pu processing, MOX, scrap recovery.

Applicability of Part 70

- All subparts are currently in force except Subpart H, for licensees authorized to possess a greater than critical mass (CM) of SNM.
- Subpart H does not apply until ISA Summary submitted or no later than October 18, 2004.
- Backfit protection for licensees with greater than a CM of SNM does not start until 1) this PPL is issued and 2) their ISA Summary is approved.
- Backfit protection for licensees with a CM or less than a CM of SNM starts as soon as this PPL is issued,


Purpose of the PPL 1-82

Provide to NRC staff (and industry)
guidance for backfits of Part 70 licensed
facilities (backfit not effective until
issuance of "staff guidance").

Description of PPL 1-82

- Guidance derived from backfit guidance of MD8.4 and PPL 1-53 for §76.76 (GDPs) and adapted for Part 70 (NMSS/FCSS).
- Adaptations included extensive use of appendices, flowcharts, graphics, and examples (utilizing plain language per SECY-98-089, DSI 14).
- Issued for stakeholder comment in June 2003.

- One external commenter NEI generally supported this PPL. Had extensive comments both positive and negative.

Stakeholder Comments (NEI)

- NE1: "it assures that any new regulatory burdens imposed...have been supported by a cost-benefit study that demonstrates...costs of implementation...are more than offset by a substantial increase provided in the overall protection of public health and safety."

- D Overuse of compliance exception (37).


Comment Resolution
