Revised Order Establishing Interim Inspection Requirements For  
Reactor Pressure Vessel Heads at Pressurized Water Reactors  
Answer to Revised Order (EA-03-009)

On February 20, 2004, the NRC issued a First Revised Order (EA-03-009) superceding the original NRC Order dated February 11, 2003, which established interim inspection requirements for the reactor pressure vessel (RPV) head at pressurized water reactors (PWRs). Florida Power & Light Company (FPL), the licensee for the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, and the Turkey Point Nuclear Plant, Units 3 and 4, and FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC (FPL Energy Seabrook) the licensee for Seabrook Station hereby submit their responses to the revised Order.


FPL and FPL Energy Seabrook will comply with the revised Order.

FPL previously submitted Relaxation Requests 1 and 2 for St. Lucie Unit 1 on November 21, 2003 (L-2003-283) and FPL requested NRC approval of the Relaxation Requests by March 22, 2004, the scheduled start date for the St. Lucie Unit 1 refueling outage, SL 1-19. FPL requests continued review and final approval of the subject Relaxation Requests by March 22, 2004.

Any future specific relaxation requests will be submitted in accordance with page 16 and 17 of the revised Order Section IV, item F(1) or F(2), as necessary.
