ORDER

(Regarding Intervenor's March 15 Motion)

We received last evening the Intervenor's "Motion to Release Filing from Protective Order, for Extension and Sanctions." In light of the content of that Motion, we are taking the steps listed below.

CFC Logistics is to file a response to the Motion by this Friday, March 19. That response should address, along with any other matters the Company wishes to include, (1) the procedures we should follow in determining the validity of a claim that certain information is proprietary (or business confidential or trade secret); and (2) the authority, if any, that we have in the realm of "sanctions" generally (the Intervenor cited none).

The NRC Staff may, if it wishes, file a response on the same points by the same deadline.

The briefing schedules on the pending matters (see yesterday's "Order Extending Briefing Time") are hereby suspended until the matters addressed in this Order are resolved.

Counsel for the Company and the Intervenor are to confer by phone on Monday, March 22, in an effort to reach an accommodation on the matters raised by Intervenor's counsel as to his ability to challenge the material embodied in the assertedly proprietary filings made by the Company. That phone call is to be initiated by Intervenor's counsel after Company counsel advises Intervenor's counsel's office as to their availability and location on that day.

Counsel for all three parties are to participate in a transcribed telephone conference call that we will convene at 3:00 P.M. on Tuesday, March 23. Information as to how to join that call will be made available by our office by the end of this week.
