SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MARCH 4, 2004, PRE-APPLICATION MEETING WITH

TRANSNUCLEAR, INC. ON NUHOMS® 32PTH SYSTEM (DOCKET No.

72-1030, TAC No. L23709)

On March 4, 2004, representatives of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Transnuclear Inc. (TN), and Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL), met to discuss TN's proposed new application, the NUHOMS® 32PTH System. A representative of Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion) was also present.

The primary purpose of the meeting was to provide an overview of the NUHOMS[®] 32PTH System, and provide a summary of the evaluations performed for the NUHOMS[®] 32PTH System. TN plans to submit the application for review the end of March 2004.

The NUHOMS® 32PTH System has the following design characteristics: 32 pressurized water reactor assemblies, 34.8 KW maximum total heat load, 5 weight percent initial fuel enrichment, 60,000 MWD burnup, and as low as 5 year cooling time. The system is designed for both intact and damaged fuel assemblies. The horizontal storage module (HSM) and the transfer cask (TC) are similar to those utilized in other NUHOMS® systems. The TC, OS187H, will use a helium backfill for improved heat transfer performance. TN provided details on the structural, thermal, and nuclear evaluation for the NUHOMS® 32PTH System, which is provided in the attached handouts. TN emphasized the similarities between this design and other previously approved TN designs.

No regulatory decisions were made at the meeting. An attendance list is included as Attachment 1. Attachment 2 includes the handouts from the meeting.
