



> Attached is the revised HI-STAR Code exceptions table. The only  
> difference from HI-STORM is an additional exception - to NB-3132 -  
> associated with the overpack closure plate bolts, port plugs and drain  
> plugs. The analogous article in NF is not a mandatory requirement, so no  
> exception is necessary. I'll fix any format and pagination as necessary  
> before both documents go out.

> Please note the following small errors in the HI-STORM exception table  
> transmitted earlier:

- >  
> 1. NG-4420: In the next-to-last sentence of the right-hand column,  
> replace "...impractical to measure the depth of weld..." with  
> "...impractical to perform repairs of weld defects...."  
>  
> 2. NB, NG, NF-4120: In the 3rd column, change the first "NF-4121.2"  
> to "NB-4121.2."  
>  
> 3. NF-3320/ NF-4720: In the first sentence of the 3rd column, delete  
> "not" (the Code requirements are applicable...)  
>

> Attached is the revised letter and table based on our conference call  
> today. I believe I addressed the comments as agreed to today, but I have  
> not done a final proofread yet. Two items remain to be resolved, but I  
> wanted to get this in your hands because I need to speak to Kris about  
> item  
> 1 below. The open items are:  
>  
> 1. Define "short duration"  
>  
> 2. Complete Table 2 serial numbers.  
>  
> Note also that we were able to delete the proposed exception to NB/NG-4132  
> which addressed reports for weld repairs. As you suspected, USTD meets  
> these requirements in their procedure 10.8 and associated repair  
> documents.  
>  
> Please get me any comments ASAP. I will amend the HI-STAR table  
> accordingly. With any luck, we can still issue these tomorrow.  
>  
> I spoke again to Tim Kobetz who said that we will need to assign these  
> requests to specific serial numbers (per the "one-time change" provision

> of  
> ISG-10) and include these changes in an amendment request for a permanent  
> change to the CoC. That's where Table 2 comes from. The good news is that  
> he did not seem taken aback by the number 169, which is the total  
> estimated  
> number of certified components to which these "one-time" changes would  
> apply (history plus future thru 2003).
