SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2003-033)

Dear Mr. Hernandez:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at the Bulbtronics Entertainment Division Hollywood facility. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether Bulbtronics willfully violated NRC requirements by distributing exempt materials, in the form of speciality lamps containing krypton-85, without an NRC license.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action regarding this investigation and considers this case closed.
