SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2003-052)

Dear Mr. Overbeck:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether a food service worker employed by Guckenheimer at your facility had been subjected to employment discrimination for having raised nuclear safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action regarding this investigation and considers this case closed.
