1. Use consistent Units
2. Use consistent terminology.
3. Do not separate numbers from units on different lines.
4. Do not separate hyphens unless a compound word. See pp 2-80.
5. Center Figure & Table Titles
6. Be careful how many acronyms are used in the document.
7. Be definite in statements ~~don't~~ do not say things like "probably", "It was thought" etc.
8. Use "plane of symmetry"
9. \* Use general plane descriptions
10. Do we need larger figures where damage is shown?
11. Provide clear criteria for "failure" for every analysis where it is ~~important~~ proper to do so. Put this criterion in an easy to find location in each section.
12. Where possible state the weak point in the case for each evaluation

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
